**Uniform Updates** – First of all, we would like to thank all of our parents and guardians in supporting our uniform policy! While most of our scholars come to school in their uniform and dressed for the weather, we still have a handful that do not. We have been working with this same group of scholars all school year to reach new levels of success in following our policy however we are not seeing a change in the behavior. These are the issues we are continuing to see:

- Scholars showing up in street clothes and changing at school. Scholars are expected to **come to school in uniform** even if they have gym first hour. In addition, they are to **remain in school uniform throughout the entire day**.
- Scholars do not come prepared for the cold weather and expect to wear their hoodie or jacket. These articles are not allowed. **Scholars were all provided a fleece or a sweater and should be wearing that**. Scholars are also allowed to wear white, black or royal blue sweaters or fleeces without the logo.
- Scholars come to school and expect to borrow a sweater, shirt or pants from our closet. This is no longer allowed. Since our district generously provided our scholars with several uniform pieces, this is not an option. The clothing in our closet is intended for emergencies, such as pants getting wet or ripping etc.
- If this behavior continues, these scholars will be calling home and we will expect you to bring in their uniform. In addition, each day a scholar is out of uniform they will be assigned a lunch detention.

Finally, we want all of our scholars to have a meaningful and successful learning environment and we appreciate your support!
